### Six Week Online Lenten Study

For our Lenten study this year, we have chosen Bishop Michael Curry's book "Love is the Way: Holding on to Hope in Troubling Times." You might have been introduced to Bishop Michael Curry at the royal wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle. His preaching was electrifying, and it was all about the power of love to change the world.

In each chapter, Bishop Curry—through his practical theology and storytelling from his own life experience—answers a question you might be asking about love: How do I find God's love? Do I have to love my enemy? Can love really change the world?

For six weeks, we will journey together in this way of love. We will cover two chapters a week, and each week will be introduced with a video and then have a group discussion guide for the week. ### Administrative Council Meeting Minutes January 5, 2021 via ZOOM

Online Attendance: Carolyn Dahl, Diane Boris, Carole Hawkinson, Julie Manisto, Sandy Wilmot, Pastor Cynthia

Carolyn called the meeting to order. She read a devotion about the New Year and then gave the opening prayer.

Secretary's Minutes: The minutes of the secretary's minutes for October were reviewed. One change was made. The Charge Conference will be after the Admin Council meeting on Feb. 2, 2021. A motion was made by Carole and second by Pastor Cynthia that the minutes be approved. Motion approved.

Treasurer & Financial Report: The Treasurer's report was reviewed. The December giving was \$7,600/ Pledges were \$42,000 last year and this year have totaled \$35,000. The back side of the pledge card asked what you would be willing to help with at the church. Many people either didn't turn the card over or just didn't put anything down. Maybe we should put "What would you be willing to help with" on a separate card. The Finance meeting will be held on January 11th at 12:30 via ZOOM.

Pastor's Report: Because the Bishop said the church may not have any in person meetings yet due to COVID, the men's group has been postponed until at least February. Our new Interim Bishop is David Bard. We need to have a Charge Conference to approved the budget for 2021. Several new committee members need to be voted in at the Charge Conference.

SPRC: Pastor Cynthia E-mailed Susan Smart about the choir director position. There are unknowns about it at this time. Whether there are enough people interested in singing in the choir or if she would be willing to bring in special music for the Sunday service. We don't know if we can afford to do that. It may be a while yet before we have Sunday worship in the church.

Trustees: We have gone to having garbage service once a month. The Cub Scouts have been shoveling the entrances.

Mission: The Advent projects collected 30 toys, 32 boxes of cereal, 100 mittens and hats, 26 coats & several packages of socks and underwear. \$75 was donated to the Loaves and Fishes mission to buy food for a meal in December. Because of the pandemic, we don't want to go to the store and shop.

Worship: Sunday worship will be online until further notice. Interim Bishop David Bard gave the sermon last Sunday. Lee Stewart from CHUM will speak this week. Phoning the congregation will continue. Maybe it will be changed from every week to every two weeks.

Other: At the February Admin Council meeting we will vote on the Budget for 2021 and get a list of the people on committees with their phone numbers. We need to send out an annual report and need to ask the office secretary make a new directory.

The next meeting will be Feb 2, at 7:00 PM via ZOOM and the Charge Conference will be right after the meeting at 7:30 via ZOOM. Pastor Cynthia gave the closing prayer. Meeting Adjourned.
