Carolyn gave the opening prayer.

The September Ad Council minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Carole and seconded by Dave that the minutes be approved. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report:

Finance Report: Pledge cards will need to be sent out. A budget meeting will be scheduled for the Sunday. October 16th after church. The SPRC and Trustees need to make their request for the 2023 Budget.

Pastors Report: The Lord's Prayer study is continuing. She represented Hillside UMC at the peace rally. She gave the sermon at Hope UMC and Coppertop.

Lay Leader: He got together with the Lay Leaders in our district online and will again this Thursday. Laity Sunday will be October 30th and LeRoy will give the sermon.

SPRC: They need to know who has a list of the people who have keys to the church. The Trustees have a list and who has signed for one.

Trustees: We need to revisit the policy of use of building and the charge for the use. The county will be redoing concrete on Piedmont Avenue next year. We may see people around measuring and surveying for this project. We United Methodist Program is switching insurance from Suracy to Sovereign. Insurance. We will change to Sovereign for our insurance. We need to have some workers compensation injury forms printed for future use.

Lamplighters: They visited Ron Scott, Bill Schilling twice and Dee Johnson. They tried to see Bea Jacobson but she had covid and they couldn't visit her. They will see Shirley Olson tomorrow.

Missions: We will be collecting warm clothes in October and hats and mittens in November. Toys will be collected for December. All these items will be brought to Union Gospel Mission for distribution. This will be put in the newsletter. We decided on where the Thanksgiving and Christmas Offerings will be collected for. A motion was made by Carole and seconded by Dave that we give the Thanksgiving Offering to Union Gospel Mission and the Christmas Offering to the Salvation Army Heat Share. Motion approved.

Worship: November 6th is All Saints Day. We will be remembering the four members of our church who passed away this past year. They are Cleo Smith, Dave Mavik, Pat Olson and Derry Gilberg. Commitment Sunday is November 13th.

Other: The Conference Youth Committee would like to use our church for their connecting with youth in our area on Saturday, January 21st. They expect 50-100 youth. This is a statewide youth conference with meetings held in Duluth, St Cloud and Minneapolis. The next meeting will be on November 1 at 7PM.

Pastor Cynthia gave the closing prayer. The meeting was adjourned.
