

I will be the new Faith Formation Pastor, primarily working with kids and youth, but also some adult education and occasional preaching. This means that I will be leaving Hillside United Methodist Church. As of right now, I do not have an ending date. Your SPRC (staff, parish relations committee) will be working with the District Superintendent, Rev. Laurie Kantonen, to find your next pastor. And Pilgrim will be sharing me with you until a good transition is planned.



Please know that this was not an easy decision for me. I LOVE being the pastor at Hillside! I couldn't have asked for a better church to be my first parish. You have taught me how to BE a pastor these past five years. We learn all sorts of stuff in seminary, but it can't teach you everything. #### CHUM: Summer Food Drive

CHUM launched its Open Your Heart Summer Food Drive that will continue into November. CHUM is gathering food and monetary donations for Thanksgiving Turkey Boxes to be distributed in November for 350 families. Last Thanksgiving, the Food Shelf served 998 families – 411 children and 158 seniors.

Contribute money to the CHUM Food Shelf through your offering to our church, and we will make sure it goes to CHUM. (Write "CHUM Food Shelf" in the memo line of your check.) As for Thanksgiving food donations, place those on the CHUM food table in fellowship hall. Examples are boxes of stuffing and mashed potatoes, canned pumpkin, corn, green beans, cream of mushroom soup, cranberry sauce, evaporated milk, and applesauce, macaroni & cheese. We'll make sure those items get to CHUM.

CHUM also sent us a thank you July 6 for our \$148 donation toward services to the hungry and homeless.



For the July meal, we made a picnic dinner for the men at Dorothy Day House. We prepared chicken salad with broasted chicken from Sam's Club. We boned the chicken and cut it into bite-size pieces and then added cooked macaroni shells, chopped onion, chopped celery, grated carrots, frozen peas and whipped dressing. We also heated some baked beans. We sent two dozen rolls, a watermelon, a box of potato chips and three dozen cookies. Additionally, we sent a large jar of peanut butter, a large Dawn dish soap, and always needed toilet paper. As usual, the meal was gratefully received. Thanks to all that helped make this mission project possible.


# Service Project Opportunity for Piedmont Elementary School
