Hillside UMC has a problem with water leaking into the building through the three cathedral shaped windows in the front- Ozark Street side. These windows run from the narthex up through the balcony above. They have been leaking for a while with water ruining adjoining plaster, wood and walls.

We have obtained a quote from Cathedral Crafts Inc. for \$9,465.00 to replace a broken pane, clean some bent lead and install plexiglass storm windows.
